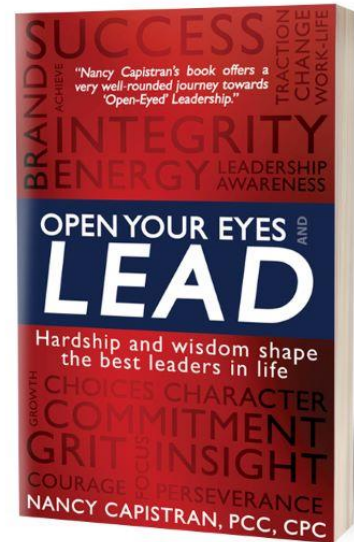


Discussion Resource Questions

They are designed to inspire critical thinking and to deepen the lessons learned for individuals / groups.



1. What is the significance of the title? How did you interpret it?
2. How would you describe the author's writing style?
3. Did you connect with the subject matter? Did it make you want to read more?
4. Does the author present information in an engaging manner?
5. Did you find the content interesting and insightful, and if so, how did the author achieve that?
6. Are the author's recommendations concrete, realistic, and actionable?
7. How does this book relate to your life or experiences?
8. What have you learned by reading this book? Has it broadened your perspective?
9. Was there a chapter or passage that stood out for you or gave you an "a-ha!" moment?
10. Did this book change or enhance your perspective — or maybe even your life?
11. Has this book inspired you to think and do anything differently in your life?
12. Did you find this book worthy enough to recommend to others? Why or why not?
13. If you had to describe how you felt about this book to a friend in just a phrase or sentence, what would you say?
